Nanette "Nan" Payne was recognized as the 2002 Ohio Athletic Conference Softball Coach of the Year and the 2002 Regional Coaching Staff of the Year. She is starting her 15th season as head softball coach at Capital University in Columbus, Ohio, and posted her 300th career win in March 2011. In her career as the winningest softball coach in school history, the Crusaders have posted a 319-201-3 record (.61 win percentage). In 2002, Nan led the Crusaders to a conference championship and an NCAA berth for only the third time in school history. In 2003, the Crusaders tied their second highest mark for wins in a season at 27. Prior to becoming the head coach at Capital, Nan served as an assistant coach at Buffalo State College for six seasons. As a player, Nan was a four-year starter for the University of Michigan softball team. She also was a Dayton Daily News All Metro Player from Northmont High School.
