Clinic Quick Facts

- Who:** Girls in grades 5-12 of any skill level or ability.
- What:** Live demonstrations will be used to illustrate solid techniques and to promote the development of imagery skills.
- Where:** The Capital Center on the campus of Capital University in Columbus, Ohio. Capital's head softball coach, Nan Payne, her coaching staff and members of her team will be on hand.
- When:** All clinics will take place from 8 a.m. to noon.
- Why:** The clinics will display and teach the basic fundamentals of fastpitch softball, specifically the skills and techniques concerned with hitting, bunting and defense.
- Cost:** Hitting – \$50 per clinic
Defense – \$50 per clinic
- Bring:** Hitting & Bunting – Participants should bring a favorite bat and helmet, but bats will be provided if needed.

Defense – Participants should bring a glove.
- Extra:** Capital softball apparel will be available for sale during the clinic.

Nan Payne Clinic Director

Since stepping on campus in 1999, Nan Payne has placed the Capital University softball team among the elite programs not only in the Ohio Athletic Conference but the entire region. In 2013, Nan and the Crusaders won the OAC regular-season championship, earning the No. 2 seed in the NCAA Tournament Angola (Ind.) Regional and setting a school record with 35 victories. Capital also hosted the OAC Tournament for the first time in school history. Nan and her assistant coaches were named the 2013 OAC Coaching Staff of the Year. The winningest softball coach in school history, Nan and the Crusaders have posted a 375-230-3 record (.62 win percentage). In 2002, she earned OAC and Central Region Coach of the Year honors, leading the Crusaders to a share of the conference championship and an NCAA berth for only the third time in school history. Prior to becoming the head coach at Capital, Nan served as an assistant coach at Buffalo State College for six seasons. As a player, Nan was a four-year starter for the University of Michigan softball team. She also was a Dayton Daily News All Metro Player from Northmont High School.

From the East on I-70

Exit at Livingston Avenue. Turn left at the light and go to Alum Creek Drive. Turn right onto Alum Creek, continuing on to Main Street. Turn right on Main. At the fourth traffic light, turn right onto Pleasant Ridge. The Capital Center is located at the northeast corner of Pleasant Ridge and Mound Street. Park in the lot across the street and enter The Capital Center through the Mound Street doors.

From the West on I-70

Exit at the Bexley/Main Street exit. Follow the ramp around onto Alum Creek Drive and continue to Main Street. Turn right on Main. At the fourth traffic light, turn right on Pleasant Ridge. The Capital Center is located at the northeast corner of Pleasant Ridge and Mound Street. Park in the lot across the street and enter The Capital Center through the Mound Street doors.
